Eden Prairie Community Center Developmental Policies



General Policies:

- All skaters (anyone taking a lesson/working on a skill) must pay before taking the ice
- Skaters are required to wear a wristband, as proof of payment
- Instructors do not have to pay, but instructors are entirely responsible to ensure that each of their skaters has paid each day, before taking the ice
- Any skater that is on the ice and has not paid, may be asked to leave the ice for the day
- Instructors are subject to fines if their skaters are on the ice without having paid the daily Developmental Ice fee
- Skaters may not take the ice until the Zamboni is off the ice and the gate is shut
- Skaters/Coaches deemed to not be considerate of other groups will be asked to leave the ice by Management

Developmental Hockey Rules:

- ALL Developmental Hockey players are required to pay & bring their stick to check in at EPCC front desk, before taking the ice. The wristband must be on the neck of the hockey stick of each skater and visible to EPCC staff
- This program offers skaters an opportunity to work on their skating skills either individually or through private lessons with an instructor
- On Ice Adult Supervision is recommended for all youth 17 and under
- Each group is allowed a maximum of 4 skaters & a coach per zone. Organized team practices are not allowed
- Hockey Nets – Maximum of 2 nets per Goal line / 4 nets per Rink (No Cross Ice Goals are Allowed)
- A helmet is required for all youth 17 and under. Additional protective hockey gear and mouth guard is recommended for safety
- Open/pick-up hockey is not allowed during Developmental Ice time
- When conducting hockey drills, please be considerate of other groups/skaters

Developmental Figure Skating Rules:

- The wristband must be on the wrist of the skater and visible to EPCC staff
- This program offers skaters an opportunity to work on their skating skills either individually or through private lessons with an instructor
- On Ice Adult Supervision is recommended for all youth 17 and under
- When conducting figure skating/ice dance drills/routines, please be considerate of other groups/individuals
- If music cannot be agreed upon by participants, the rinks stereo system will have to be turned off

Developmental Tot Hockey:

A special designated tot hockey session is the perfect place to start working on your hockey skills

- Developmental Tot Hockey is on designated mornings throughout the year
- Mini-hockey nets are provided. Participants should bring their own pucks and sticks
- Participants are required to adhere to all developmental hockey policies and procedures
- Participants may not take the ice until the Zamboni is off the ice and the doors are shut
- Parents are allowed on the ice with the child at no additional charge, but must be on ice skates
