

## Off Leash Dog Areas

### User Etiquette

- Don't bring a sick dog to the park.
- Dog handlers must have a leash available for each dog at all times. Any dog exhibiting aggressive behavior must be leashed and removed immediately.
- Dog handlers must closely supervise their dog and be within view. Children under age 12 cannot supervise dogs.
- Dogs must be under voice or whistle control at all times.
- Maximum of two dogs per handler.
- Don't leave human garbage, food, food wrappers, cigarette butts, etc. where dogs can reach them.
- Where provided, humans must stay off agility equipment.
- Properly socialized and trained dogs make better pets and better visitors to the park. Train your dog in basic obedience.
- Children must be supervised:
  - o Do not allow running or screaming. Many dogs are not raised with children. A child who runs or screams can trigger a dog's herding or prey instinct i.e. chasing or biting.
  - o Do not give children treats to pass out to strange dogs. Treats can create competition. Children may be caught in the middle.
  - o Do not allow your child to approach strange dogs without permission from the owner. A strange dog could feel challenged by a child's overly friendly approach and may snap or growl.

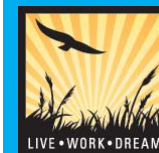

# City of Eden Prairie Off Leash Dog Areas

**1 Staring Lake Park**  
13800 Pioneer Trail  
This 5.7 acres of fenced area is located adjacent to the Staring Lake Archery Range, near the historic Cummins-Grill House. It offers spacious woods, an open area and natural walking paths.

This location is closed for off-leash dog use during the winter months when it is utilized as a nordic ski trail area.

This 9.3 acre site has a separate area for small dogs. See details about daily fee or pass.



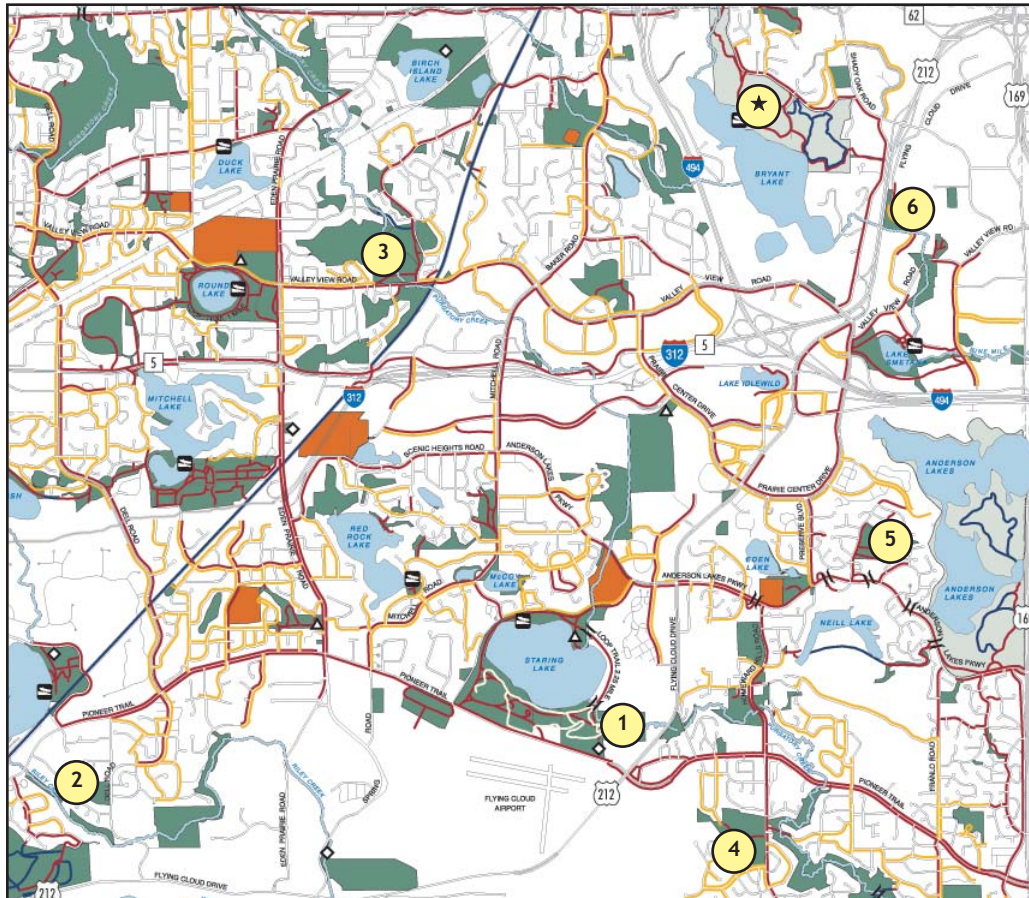
## Park Hours & Information

### City Park Hours

- 6 a.m. - 10 p.m.

### Dog License

- \$20 for 2 years
- Available for EP residents and non-residents.
- Purchase at main desk at City Center, 8080 Mitchell Rd.



## Off Leash Dog Areas Rules & Regulations

- Use hours are 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.
- Dogs must be licensed in Eden Prairie and properly vaccinated.
- Eden Prairie Dog License can be obtained at City Center (8080 Mitchell Road) for \$20. A copy of the rabies certification from your veterinarian is required.
- Leash dogs while entering and exiting the off leash area.
- By law, you are responsible for damage and injuries inflicted by your dog.
- Individual dogs known to be aggressive are not permitted.
- Clean up after your dog and dispose of waste properly.
- Children under the age of 12 must be closely supervised by an adult. Children age 6 and under are not allowed within the off leash area.
- No glass containers.
- No smoking.
- No female dogs in season.
- No unauthorized motorized equipment or vehicles.
- No bikes.

★ **Bryant Lake Park** is a regional park (not a city park). It is operated by the Three Rivers Park District. A \$5 daily fee, payable at the drop box, is required for use of this dog park; or you may purchase a \$30 annual pass at [threeriversparkdistrict.com](http://threeriversparkdistrict.com).
